LITERACY QUILT-KINDY

Last Friday Kindy parents met to discuss strategies they could use at home to help develop early Literacy skills. Early oral literacy skills are the foundation for reading and writing as learning becomes more formalised in the later years of schooling. Simone Rodriguez (Pre Primary teacher) led the workshop and discussed strategies that parents might like to do at home with their children.

Reading every day to your child cannot be over emphasized. As you read your child is hearing the sounds, vocabulary, and grammar of English. What a wonderful way for children to be immersed in language.

Among many other things Simone discussed rhyming, initial sounds and re-tell (narrative). The emphasis on all of these early literacy skills is oral language through play. If you missed the session and would like to attend another please leave your name with Cathy Barbera (Kindy teacher).
