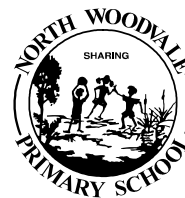

This is based on the nutritional value of the food/drink and the amount of sugar, salt, sodium and other preservatives.

We are now at the stage that we will be supporting further improvements and looking for even better alternatives. One example is to try and find a drink that has less sugar than the other alternatives that have been suggested by the WA canteen Association.

Therefore we will not be supporting the sale of high sugar content drinks and we ask that these are not brought into the school.

We will be promoting the sale of water drinks and low sugar fruit and milk drinks. More to come on this important topic - please get behind your school and support your child drinking and eating only healthy, low sugar and low salt foods!

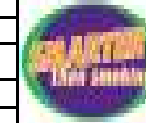
