DENTAL THERAPY CENTRE

Advice to Parents

RE: ATTENDANCE AT DENTAL APPOINTMENTS

With Winter/Influenza season approaching and the need to contain the spread of infection, it is wise to take simple precautions to minimise transmission of all respiratory infections.

As part of this process, if your child feels unwell, has high fever, cough and/or sore throat, they should not attend for dental treatment.

You are advised to contact the Dental Therapy Centre to cancel your child's appointment and make another appointment for your child at a later date.

If your child is **in pain or requiring urgent treatment**, this can be discussed and arranged with staff at the clinic.

Those children who attend with symptoms of illness will not be treated.
