DISCO

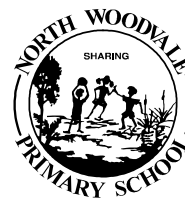

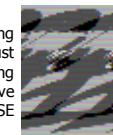

EFFECT!

I was fortunate enough to attend a principal's conference last week and came away very inspired by what we can do as educators and as parents. I won't try to bore you with too much detail but over the next few weeks I will indicate what factors do have a considerable 'effect' on a child's development. These factors will be taken from a recent study completed by a very notable (and favourite of mine) professor, Mr John Hattie. John is currently the professor of Education at Auckland University and director of the visible learning lab.

One of many very important 'effects' on child learning was 'goal setting'. This focus is not about regimenting a child's thinking or to attempt to make them grow up before their time, but rather, begin to consider options, what is required to achieve them and gear their efforts accordingly. Such an approach will benefit their decision-making in the years to come.

To quote Walt Disney, "**If you can dream it, you can do it**", so with this in mind, before we teach them we must first reach them.

A "can do" and "want to" approach is an essential ingredient to a successful education and life and as such should be encouraged. Sitting down with your child and discussing their goals and not just what they want to achieve on the sporting field is a good option and one that needs revisiting from time to time.

FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE:

As a follow up to previous week's information on the Health and Hygiene of your child consider the following points:

- Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell especially if they have an influenza like illness ie. Fever and 1 or more of cough, sore throat, runny nose or nasal congestion, and stay away from school until well.

- Simple steps to help prevent spread of ANY germs that can cause illness are:-

- Avoid contact with people who are unwell.

First person to see me and tell me how they solved the puzzle will win a prize. *Have fun!*

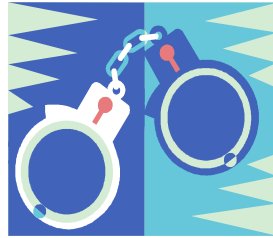
Who is Guilty?

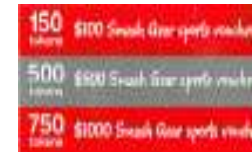
Above: Action photos of North's amazing last minute modcrosse win. **Above right:** North levels the score with a great goal.
