Craigie Heights Dental Therapy Centre will be closed for the duration of the 3rd term. During this time other clinics will cover for emergencies only. Please see below.

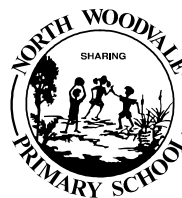

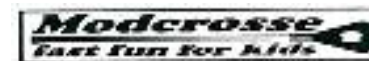


DISTRICT INTERSCHOOL WINTER SPORTS CARNIVAL CANCELLED

PHYSICAL EDUCATION REPORT

This semester, the students participated in a comprehensive skill development program, which included spatial awareness, body management, locomotion, object control and strategies & tactics. At the conclusion of the P.E. Program they were required to demonstrate balancing, running and control of a variety of balls & equipment in a supportive environment. A 'C' grade is considered 'satisfactory', however, it is normal for children to develop physical skills at different rates. A number of factors can effect this rate such as confidence and size, especially in Years 1-3.
