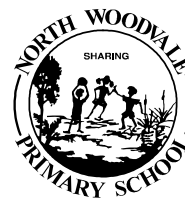

NUMBER NOVELTIES

House number and age

- Write your house number eg 98
- Multiply by 2 196
- Add 5 201
- Multiply by 50 10050
- Add your age 10158
- Add 365 10523
- Subtract 675 9848

The answer should contain your house number and age. Try this trick on your friends.

Date of birth


To find the date and month of a person's birth, follow these steps. Ask the person to:

- Write the number of the month in which you were born eg. 12 (for December)
- Multiply by 5 60
- Write a 3 at the right-hand side of the product obtained 603
- Add 12 615
- Multiply by 2 1230
- Add the date of the month in which you were born 1239

Stop and ask the person for the total.
Subtract 30 from the total and the answer will contain the date and month of the person's birth. In the example above, the person was born on 28/12.

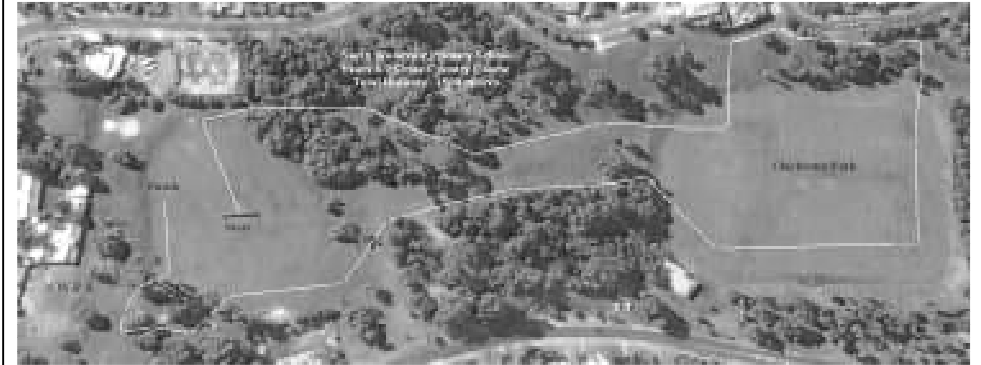

Blue = Hovea



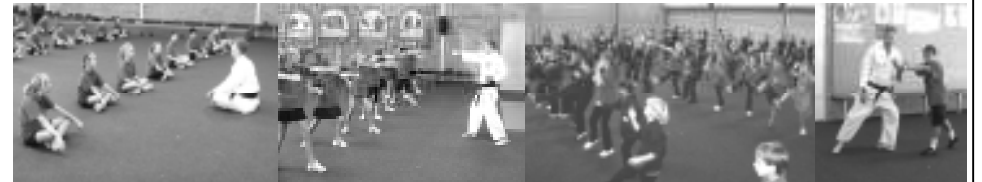
WEST COAST AIKIDO FITNESS & LIFE SKILLS CLASSES
