### FROM THE PRINCIPAL

#### BULLYING?

This is a serious issue and one we all need to be vigilant in preventing or assisting those students involved.

Bullying may take the form of; teasing, spreading rumours, threatening, name calling, repeated putting someone down, deliberately ignoring, taking or damaging property, physically hurting people or deliberate social exclusion and increasingly in this modern era sending hurtful text messages.

This list is by no means complete and you as a parent need to be on the lookout that your child is not suffering. Loss of appetite, not talking, reduced sleep and not wanting to come to school are the obvious signs – please do not leave it and hope your child will cope. Please talk with your child's teacher or if not convenient discuss with an admin person.

At Nth Woodvale PS we are very aware that bullying does occur from time to time. It is not something that we see that often, in fact the vast majority of students interact very well. However, recognising and communicating instances of this between school and home is extremely vital with all stakeholders needing to play a role.

Please be aware that your school will:

- Inform parents immediately that bullying has occurred.
- Help both the victim and the child who is bullying.
- Ask that parents do follow up at home and support any decision that is made at school.
- Work collaboratively with parents of children who are victims or who are involved in bullying.
